REQUIREMENTS

BASIC FILMMAKING: THE SILENT FILM

- Graduate Level
- Students are expected to bring their production equipment for shoots (at least five basic equipment packages: camera, lights, sound kit, etc.).
- Students must know an editing software or get editors who know the software.
- Every student must have an existing short script that will be shot by student crews.

WRITING THE FEATURE- LENGTH SCREENPLAY

- This is an advanced course.
- Students attending this course are expected to have prior experience in writing scripts whether in the short or long forms.

CINEMATOGRAPHY

- This is an intensive course.
- Students are expected to have a working knowledge on the different visual tools, his role in relation to the director, knows how to do script analysis, tell a story using the visual tools and has a practical grounding in real-life production situations in the Philippines.

GUIDELINES

- Application form and sample works must be submitted to the CCP Film, Broadcast and New Media Division office, 4th Floor, CCP Main Bldg., Roxas Blvd., Pasay City on or before 7 April 2017.

- Interview of applicants will be held on April 19-20 at the Cultural Center of the Philippines.
- Selected applicants will be informed via email or SMS on or before 2 May 2017.

MECHANICS

- The applicant must have an undergraduate degree. If not, he/she should be an undergrad preferably in literature, theater, film, creative writing, visual arts or photography.
- A screening committee made up of the faculty and CFI Members shall evaluate applicants based on the application form submitted.
- Interested parties can download an application form from **www.cinemalaya.org** and **www.culturalcenter.gov.ph**
- If approved, applicants will be invited for a one-on-one interview.
- Once accepted, the candidate will be notified through email and/or SMS.
- Only candidates who have been notified through email and/or SMS will be eligible for enrolment.
- The enrollee will pay the tuition in full through cash or check to the Cinemalaya Foundation Inc. (CFI).
- The student who completes the course will receive a Certificate of Completion.
